Boulder City Library Homebound Service

What is Homebound Service?

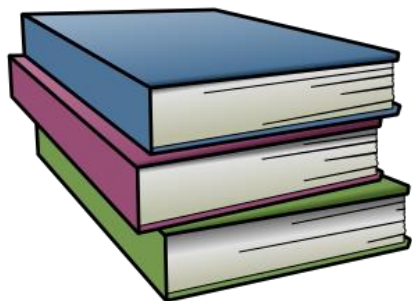
The purpose of the Homebound Services provided by the Boulder City Library is to extend library services to those residents of the City of Boulder City, NV, who may not otherwise be able to visit the library.

Who is eligible for this service?

You must be a Boulder City Resident who is unable to visit the Library. These services are designed for both short term and long term.

Confirmation by Boulder City Library's Homebound Coordinator is required.

Services may also be extended to the in-home caregiver of an established homebound patient.



How does it work?

To fit the needs of our patrons, we offer a two tier system.

Tier 1: Pickup

If you have a family member or friend who can visit the library to pick up your items, Tier 1 is for you. We will select items based on your reader survey or items you have requested and have them ready at the Circulation Desk for pickup. Loan periods will be extended. Renewals are available online or by phone as long as there are no holds.

Tier 2: Delivery

A library representative will deliver books to your place of residence on a set schedule. We will select items based on your reader survey or items you have requested. Loan periods will be extended. Renewals are available online or by phone as long as there are no holds. We will waive overdue fines should the Library Service be unavailable on the due date.

What materials are available?

Currently we provide items owned by the Boulder City Library. If you have internet, we also provide In-Home Instruction for using our online services such as our catalog, magazines, electronic books and audio books and databases. The patron must have a computer at home with access to the internet to receive this instruction.
